imc FAMOS is an application for analyzing, evaluating and documenting measurement results.

For the purpose of analysis and evaluation, a wide range of display styles are available for the measurement data. The display styles include simple function plots, display of multiple waveforms with either a common or with separate, individually set scaling, texts, tables, as well as 3D-displays as Waterfall or color maps.

For the purposes of analysis and evaluation, a great variety of mathematics functions are available. Besides standard math operations, these functions also include special functions for signal analysis such as digital filters, FFT etc.

Along with step-by-step manual analysis, all procedures can easily be automated with macros. For the purpose of this automation, there is a dialog editor in addition to the analysis functions, which provides the ability to develop one's own user interface for automated analysis procedures.

The analysis and evaluation results can be documented totally automatically in measurement reports. These can be generated in a variety of formats – including automatic composition of PDF-documents.

A built-in Data Browser is included, which helps to quickly and efficiently find, display and print out the right data from vast stocks.

This expansion kit for imc FAMOS contains not only familiar functions for durability and fatigue analysis but also some very practical new ones. Diverse counting and classification procedures, particularly Rainflow analysis, are available.

Functions	Description
Rainflow	The Rainflow matrix and the Residue are calculated on the basis of a loading time function. Numerous options are provided in order to be able to adapt the algorithm to the user's needs. Along with the basic functions there is a stock of special functions for working with the Rainflow matrix, for example superpositioning, addition of extra load spectra, extraction of single load spectra from the matrix, and determining of other counting results such as range-pairs in the Rainflow matrix.
Fatigue calculation	From the Rainflow count and the tested material's Wöhler line, a linear fatigue accumulation measurement is conducted. Thus, an entire fatigue calculation can be performed by imc FAMOS by means of just a few function calls.
Standard class-counting procedure	All class-counting procedures conforming to DIN 45667 (such as level-crossing, range-pair) are available. Particularly helpful are functions for determining one- and two-dimensional histograms. Even one- and two-dimensional revolution class counts can be calculated.
TrueMax procedure	Even in a correctly sampled signal, extreme values do not always coincide with samples. However, for a Rainflow analysis, correct capture of these extremes value is crucial. Simply use the procedure specially designed for this application.

The Python-Kit supplies functions which provide a bridge to the **Python** programming language.

imc FAMOS generates an embedded instance of the **Python** runtime environment, which provides an interpreter for the **Python** programming language.

Python is an all-purpose object-oriented programming language which enjoys widespread prevalence especially in education and science/technology due to its accessibility for beginners, its platform independence, expandability and its free availability (Open Source). A large number of libraries are available, e.g. for numerical calculations, visualization of data, image analysis and all the way to machine learning. Familiar expansion libraries for the field of science and technology include **NumPy**, **SciPy** and **TensorFlow**.

There are functions for reading and writing **Python**-variables, as well as for executing **Python**-functions and code lines, or even whole **Python** programs.

imc FAMOS VideoPlayer

The kit is part of **imc FAMOS Edition Enterprise** or higher.

This browser built into the imc FAMOS user interface enables access to the ASAM ODS-server. The entire ODS database can be searched for measured data and the associated descriptive data.

An extensive kit is available which provides access to the ASAM ODS server in automated evaluations.

The browser includes very helpful filter functions for the purpose of better navigating through large stores of data. A practical Preview window also simplifies regular database operations. Measured data and extra properties can be downloaded from the server. It is also possible to upload measurement channels from imc FAMOS to the server.

These capabilities make imc FAMOS a very powerful client of an ASAM ODS server.

The ODS server used must provide an interface in accordance with **ASAM ODS specification version 5.x**. ODS servers of versions up to 3.2 and from 6.0 are not supported.
